## Leeds Integrated Transport Partnership

### Terms of reference

The Leeds Integrated Transport Partnership exists to promote a sustainable transport infrastructure for the city, and to develop a broad consensus between business, the community, and the statutory agencies as to the steps, which are required.

### Objectives

#### By:

- Considering the continued development and delivery of the West Yorkshire Leeds Transport Strategy in the context of the Leeds Transport Strategy (1991)
- Promoting a shared understanding of the options available in relation to public transport and highways schemes and developing a consensus on the approach to be taken
- Monitoring and evaluating progress in meeting the objectives of the Leeds Transport Strategy and the Vision for Leeds
- Influencing public opinions including investors and developers, ensuring that the facts about proposed policy are communicated and understood, and that Leeds' case for investment is communicated to government
- Developing linkages to ensure transport developments contribute to the delivery of the Vision for Leeds as a whole
- Ensuring Leeds connects with partners and partnerships across the West Yorkshire and the Yorkshire and the Humber region to promote an integrated transport approach and regional coherence
